As Ratepayers are aware, **Bill 33: The Municipal Modernization Act** was introduced in the Manitoba Legislature on May 01, 2013. This bill requires all municipalities with fewer than 1,000 residents to submit an amalgamation plan with its partner or partners (neighbouring municipalities) by **December 01, 2013**.

The majority of the Council feel that it is in the best interest of our ratepayers to enter into discussion with the Rural Municipality of Silver Creek; as the two municipalities have common ground with agriculture, lake developments, water plants, L.U.D.'s
